

ONCOLOGY NURSING CONSIDERING CHILD COMPANION – BIBLIOMETRIC STUDY

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INTRODUCTION

Although cancer is not very common in children, it is a considerable cause of child mortality nowadays. The most frequent neoplasias that affect children are leukemias, nervous system tumors, central system tumors and lymphomas. Very often the nursing team is responsible for giving support for the children family and, consequently, it is known as a reference due to their care to the patient and the recognition of the importance of family for the promotion and maintenance of health. The nursing assistance to hospitalized children under oncologic treatment, aim the child well being in combination with the presence and participation of the family. Therefore, the nursing team is responsible for comply with the child needs and give assistance to children and their family.

Objective

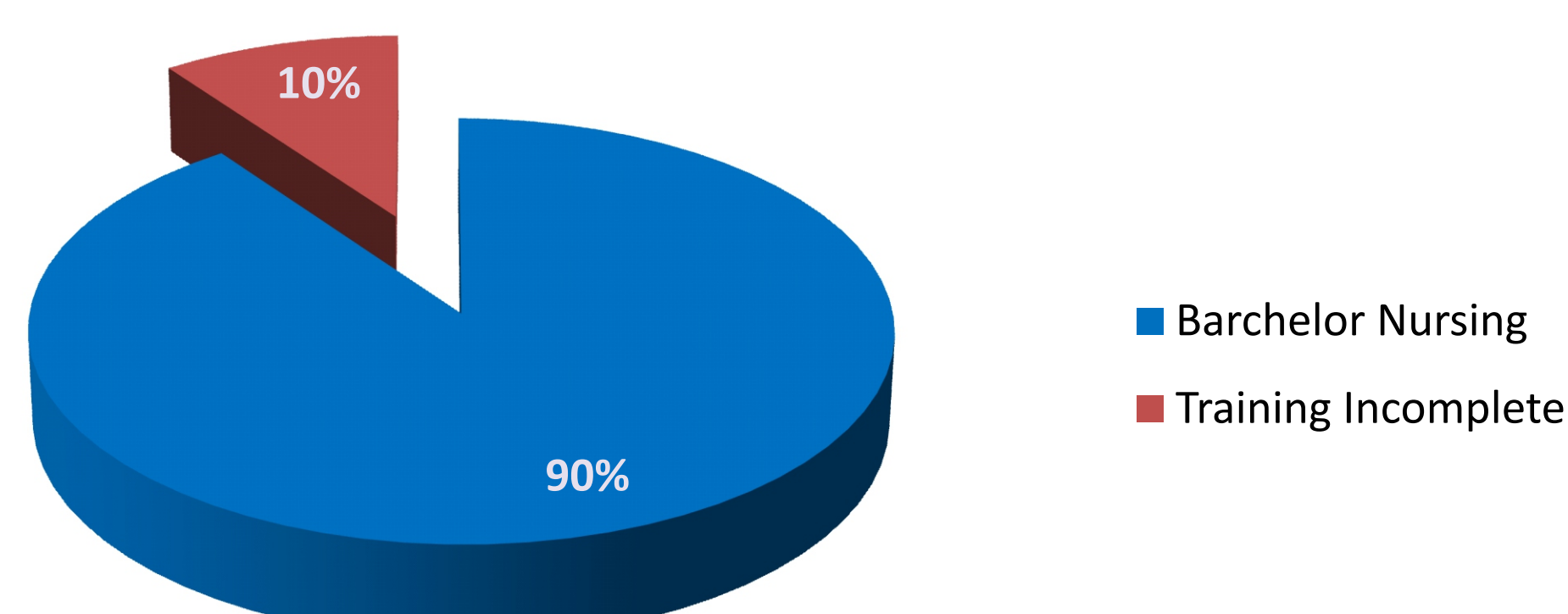
To classify the original articles of nursing in relation with the informed descriptors published in the SciELO database, Brazil.

METHODOLOGY

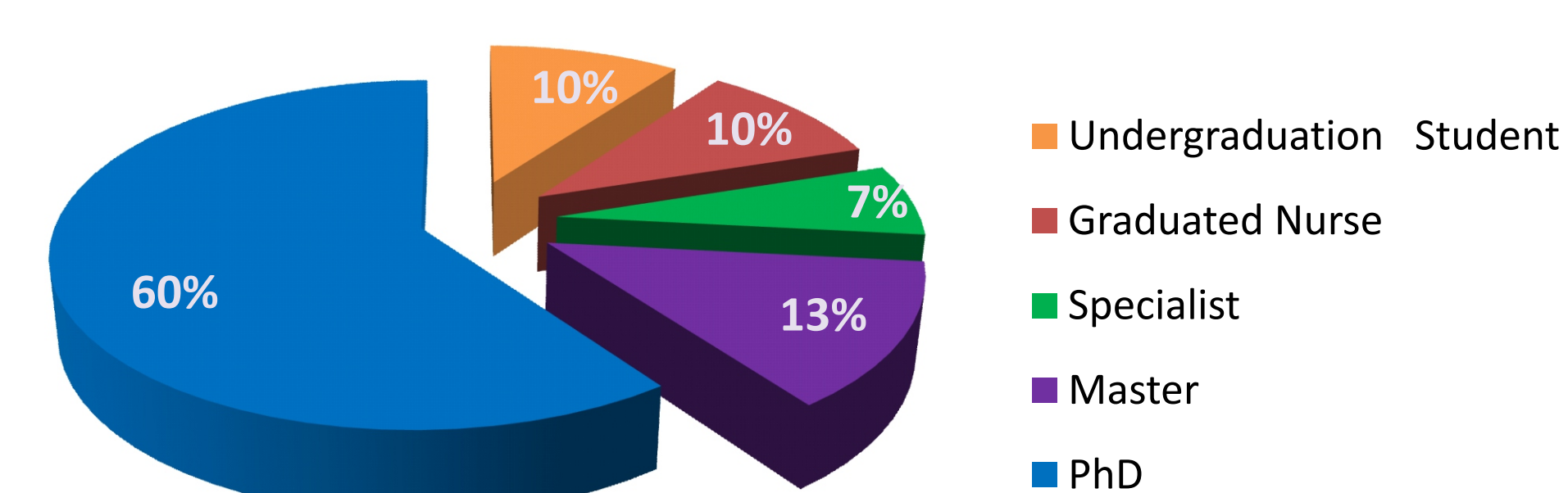
Bibliometric study as a method for the obtainment of indicators for the evaluation of scientific production. The bibliometric research it is based on studies in which the basis were bibliographic and indexed data. The present research was conducted through the selection of original articles about nursing that utilized descriptors from Science of Health (DeCS): oncology nursing, family and childcare. The articles were analyzed according to bibliometric data related to: professional formation, academic degrees and where the authors work, the institution to which they are linked to, and in which periodic the articles were published.

CONCLUSION

14 articles were identified from the selected descriptors. These articles represent the whole sample for the study analysis. Identified themselves as to the training, 90% of authors are nurses, professor doctor titulation prevalent (60%), as to the institution of action, most have links with a public university in department of Nursing Education, located mainly in the Southern and Southeastern Brazil, as the publication period, there is an equitable distribution in the period 2004-2013, predominantly in the Journal Text and Context and Journal of School Nursing USP. This study demonstrate the importance of the topics involving the oncology nursing, the care for children and their family in relation to the publications of the health professionals and the use of the available resources in SciELO.
